**SUBJECT: Reminder: Advanced Earned Income Credit, Form W-5, Has Been Repealed**

This is a reminder that the new legislation has repealed the Advanced Earned Income Credit (AEIC) provision. For employees who are currently enrolled the credit will expire as scheduled on December 31, 2010. Effective January 1, 2011, the NYC Department of Education will no longer accept Form W-5, the Earned Income Credit Advance Payment Certificate.

Eligible employees will still be able to claim the Earned Income Credit (EIC) on their personal income tax returns. However, employees will no longer be allowed to receive a portion of it with each paycheck. This is in compliance with a provision of HR 1586 (Public Law 111-226, section 219).
